Wide Horizon stands ready to minister to a wide variety of needs of those seeking healing in Christian Science.

Those seeking healing – those who are relying completely on Christian Science for healing and working with a Christian Science practitioner – are welcome to come for care from our Christian Science nurses. Wide Horizon also offers a haven from the world – a place to rest and restore and to regain a sense of peace. Whether you're a college student on overload, a parent in need of a respite from daily demands, an isolated adult who would benefit from a helping hand, or someone eager to be in an atmosphere that supports their practice of Christian Science – in these instances and many others, it can make all the difference to be surrounded by people who share and will gladly support your trust in God to heal.

FACILITY CARE The facility offers around-the-clock care from Christian Science nurses who are trained and experienced in caring for a full range of needs. Whether the patient is up and about or needs to receive care in bed at present, Christian Science nurses minister skillfully and patiently to the human need while also providing loving encouragement and support of a patient's spiritual study and quiet individual prayer in one of our 25 private rooms.

OUTPATIENT CARE Individuals who do not require an overnight stay and who can make the trip to Wide Horizon are also warmly welcomed. Outpatient care might include cleansing and bandaging, or assistance and instruction in using mobility aids such as crutches or walkers. We can also help with a shower in an easy-access shower or even a shampoo in our beauty salon. Please call our main number to arrange your visit.

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL Students of Christian Science who seek a respite from daily cares through Rest and Study or a peaceful retreat for extended Supervised Residential Living are invited to Horizon House, where private suites plus daily meals are provided for short or extended stays. Christian Science nursing and administrative staff at Wide Horizon are Christian metaphysicians, prayerfully maintaining a loving atmosphere to support the healing treatment patients receive from a Christian Science practitioner. TOUCH OF HOME A full-service kitchen provides home-style meals for the needs of patients and guests. Meals are served daily in our dining room, or privately in the guest's room. Snacks are available throughout the day. A spacious living room complete with fireplace, piano and TV/DVD, offers a gathering place for guests and patients to relax, visit and attend daily programs.

ENGAGING ACTIVITIES Staff and volunteers provide an active and inspirational agenda of daily programming and events. These include reading of the weekly Christian Science Bible Lesson, inspirational music, movies, local performers, games, crafts, and Dominion in Movement.
