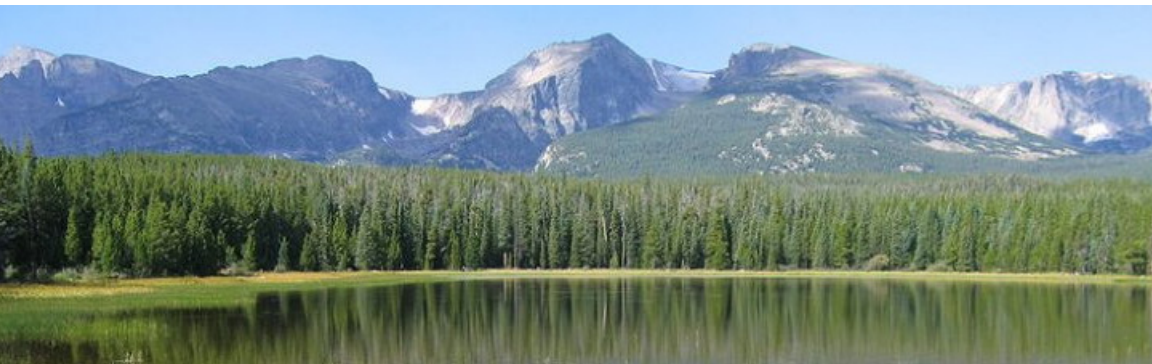

The facility was born out of love for the healing mission of Christian Science and faithfulness to the Master’s command to His followers to “heal the sick.”

Christian Science nursing is a calling – it is a demonstration of the love that is “the fulfilling of the law,” that Christly care which loves one’s neighbor as oneself. Christian Science nurses provide practical care to students of Christian Science who are relying solely on God for the healing of any physical ill. Nursing staff is on site around-the-clock to meet the needs of patients any time.

CHRISTIAN SCIENCE NURSING SERVICES

Wide Horizon offers services to meet the many needs of those seeking physical healing. The facility has 24 private rooms with nurses on duty twenty-four hours a day, enabling nursing services to be provided daily or around-the-clock when necessary. Patients who do not require overnight stays are also warmly welcomed.

Christian Science Nursing Care. The highest level of Christian Science nursing services are lovingly provided to guests with significant physical needs or those who are confined to bed.

Christian Science Care. Lower levels of nursing care aid guests who are ambulatory and able to handle basic personal tasks, including meals, on their own.

Outpatient Services. For those who can travel to Wide Horizon, but do not need to stay at the facility, Christian Science nurses can minister to a variety of patients’ needs on-site, including dressing and bandaging of wounds, etc.

Visiting Nurse (At-Home Care). Christian Science nurses can arrange to visit your home to provide care when needed, in some cases on an emergency basis. Please call the front desk to check nurse availability.

HEALING ATMOSPHERE

Nursing and administrative staff at Wide Horizon are Christian metaphysicians, prayerfully maintaining a loving atmosphere to support the healing treatments patients receive from a Christian Science practitioner. A well-stocked on-site Library supplies books, Christian Science periodicals, and other reference materials for study.



INSPIRATION & ACTIVITIES

Touch of Home. A full-service home-style kitchen meets the needs of patients and guests, with three meals served daily in our Dining Room, or privately in the guest's room. Snacks are available throughout the day. A spacious living room, complete with fireplace, piano and TV/DVD, offers a gathering place for guests and patients to relax, visit and attend daily programs.

Engaging Activities. Wide Horizon staff and volunteers provide an active and inspirational agenda of programming and events daily. These include reading of the weekly Christian Science Bible Lesson, inspirational music, movies, local performers, games and crafts.

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL - REST & STUDY

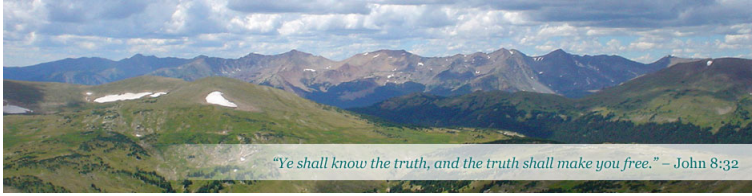


Serving the Cause of Christian Science

Mary Baker Eddy writes in *Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures* specifically about the importance of the nurse's role in healing the sick: that nurse who is "cheerful, orderly, punctual, patient, full of faith, — receptive to Truth and Love" will be an aid to the case! (*S&H, p. 395*)

Christian Science nursing is a critical aspect of the Christian Science movement – one that daily demonstrates the effectiveness of Christian Science healing under any circumstance. Each Christian Science nursing facility stands as a bulwark against the onslaught of *materia medica* and its push toward formalized health care and unquestioning reliance on drugs to combat illness. Christian Scientists know that "the Christ is here, all dreams of error breaking, unloosing bonds of all captivity." (*Christian Science Hymnal, 412*)

Wide Horizon, as a Christian Science nursing care facility, fulfils the provision in the Church Manual for Christian Science nursing. Most importantly, this loving care fulfils the emphatic command of the Christ to "Heal the sick!"

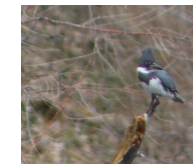
Our phone number is 303-424-4445. Phones are answered 24/7. We welcome your call for service at any time, and are happy to answer questions you may have.

HOW TO GET HERE

Take I-70 to either the Wadsworth or Kipling exit. Drive south about one mile to 38th Avenue. From Wadsworth, turn right on West 38th Avenue; from Kipling, turn left. The entrance to Wide Horizon is on the south side of West 38th Avenue about halfway between Wadsworth and Kipling.
